#### **Tuition:**

- Full-time per credit hour (12 or more hours): \$ 278.00
- Part-time per credit hour (11 or less hours): \$308.00
- Per credit hour by examination: \$55.00
- Course exemption by examination: \$30.00

- Books and supplies average \$1300.00 per year.
- Full uniforms are approximately \$300.00.
- Living expenses, transportation, costs for affiliations, field trips, insurance (health and liability), uniforms, testing fees, hospitalization, workshops, immunizations, physicals, license fees, announcements, etc. are the responsibility of the student.

- Application fee: \$ 25.00
- General fee per credit hour (*Includes the cost of up to five transcripts per year*): \$5.00
- Nursing lab fee: \$75.00
- Nursing testing fee: \$70.00
- Nursing Program Fee (*per year*): \$65.00
- Matriculation fee: \$60.00
- Late registration fee: \$30.00
- ID Replacement fee: \$10.00
- Late tuition payment fee: \$25.00
- Liability insurance (once per year): \$15.00
- Graduation fee: \$100.00

### Kent State - Trumbull out-of-state student fee notice:

#### **Out-of-state students enrolled at Kent State-Trumbull:**

Nonresident students enrolled for 11 or more credit hours pay, in addition to the other required fees, a Tuition Surcharge Fee of \$3,716 per semester. Nonresident students enrolled for less than 11 credit hours pay a Tuition Surcharge Fee of \$338 per hour plus the regular part-time hourly fee.
