Students With No Previous College Credits

Note: Admission to the Nursing Program is competitive and is granted to the best qualified candidates. There are frequently more applicants than available spaces. Applicants will be reviewed only when application files are complete. All prerequisite courses must be completed prior to review. Students will be ranked based on the point system below.

An applicant must either be a high school graduate with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.7, or a general equivalency diploma (GED) recipient with a score of 570.
