**Student Selection Criteria for Admission into the Associate Degree Nursing Program (Point System)**

**Students With College Credits – Current Mercy College Students and Transfer Students**

**Note: Admission to the Nursing Program is competitive and is granted to the best qualified candidates. There are frequently more applicants than available spaces. Applicants will be reviewed only when application files are complete. All prerequisite courses must be completed prior to review. Students will be ranked based on the point system below.**

An applicant must either be a high school graduate or a general equivalency diploma (GED) recipient. Pre-requisite courses (Algebra, Biology, and Chemistry) are not used in calculating the GPA used for admission.

You must complete a **Candidacy for Program of Study Application** with your academic advisor and submit the form to the Office of Student Records no later than January 1<sup>st</sup> of the year you wish to begin nursing courses.
